Adjunct Instructors Wanted

Houston Graduate School of Theology invites applications for adjunct instructors in the following areas:

- Counseling (LPC/LMFT tracks) – Terminal degree preferred
- Counseling Statistics – Master’s degree or higher
- Homiletics/Preaching – D.Min. or Ph.D. preferred
- Philosophy of Religion – Specialized Master’s degree or higher
- World Religions – Terminal degree preferred
- Pastoral Care and Leadership – Th.M. or higher
- Biblical Studies – Ph.D./Th.D. preferred

HGST is a diverse but close-knit Christian community. The members of the HGST Family come from many denominations or church backgrounds, representing a wide variety of worship styles and personal expressions of faith. We celebrate these differences because, rooted in our unity in Christ, they function as our greatest strength.

Adjunct instructors report to the Dean of the Faculty and are invited to attend the Faculty Assembly during the semester(s) in which they teach. Adjunct rank is commensurate with experience, credentials, and length of service to HGST.

The Academic Year is divided into Fall and Spring semesters, two summer terms, a Bridge Term and, from time to time, intensive week-long mini terms (e.g. January, May). The schedule for the Fall and Spring semesters coincides approximately with that of most colleges and universities in Houston. Classes are typically held in 2 ½ hour sessions once a week for fifteen weeks during the traditional semester. Day, evening, and weekend class times are available.

Compensation is based on the number of students enrolled, ranging from \$1,400 to \$2,150 per course per semester.
